**MEMORANDUM DECISION &  
DISMISSAL ORDER**

Plaintiff filed a prisoner civil rights complaint,<sup>1</sup> and was granted *in forma pauperis* status.<sup>2</sup> However, Plaintiff has not obeyed the Court's September 12, 2016 order to file within thirty days a "certified copy of the trust fund account statements . . . for the 6-month period immediately preceding the filing of the complaint . . . obtained from the appropriate official of each prison at which prisoner is confined."<sup>3</sup> The order was returned to sender, marked, "NOT AT THIS ADDRESS." No forwarding address has been submitted.

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that--for failure to obey the Court's order and to prosecute this case--Plaintiff's case is DISMISSED without prejudice. This case is CLOSED.
